Your prayers and giving and personal involvement in missions ministry are the backbone of what God is doing through AGWM around the world.



Peru's Quechua Fire

Incan descendants are coming to Christ

"This one's still smoldering," Chris calls out, nudging the stones around the charred fire pit. "Someone burned sacrifices on it just this morning."

Not 50 meters from the pagan altar stands a cross, a replica of the one planted on the hill by the Spanish nearly three centuries ago. Most Quechua mix Catholicism with Incan rituals, performing the rosary before sacrificing to pacify spirits.

Chris and Debbie Bowser, AGWM missionaries to Peru, are partnering with the Peruvian Assemblies of God to plant churches and train pastors among the Quechua people in the Cusco region of Peru. A mighty move of God has begun among the Quechua, who are turning from idols to serve the living God in record numbers—so quickly that there are not enough churches or pastors to catch up with them.

The high place belongs to the village of Huayllarcococha, a community with no evangelical church. One of the

only believers in the village, an elderly woman named Marcusu Huamán, has decided to do something about it.

Marcusa lives alone, abandoned by her son and extended family because of her conversion to Christianity. Her "family" now are the Christians from other villages who gather in her sheep corral. "I'm building this place for God's children—and for my relatives when they come to Christ."

We pray with Marcusu before leaving, agreeing with her in faith that God will plant this church, restore her family, and turn the entire village to the Lord. As we walk to our car in the frigid night air, she calls out after us, "Don't forget Peru! Pray for my country!"

The Peruvian Assemblies of God has existed for 98 years, but its discipleship materials are only available in Spanish—not in the

Quechua language. With the dawn of this indigenous revival, the Bowsers are now partnering with the Peruvian AG to facilitate the translation of these resources.

"Over 1.3 million Quechua live here in the Cusco region," Chris explains, "and we have some Quechua pastors who've never been credentialed, never had a course on the Bible or theology, and cannot locate books in the Bible."

"It breaks my heart when people say that Latin America is reached," Chris says as he points out the car window

during a drive between villages. "There is no church in this village. Look at these people: They've never heard the gospel! The unreached are all around us!"

As the Spirit of God lights hearts faster than a thousand pagan altars can catch fire, I close my trip in a time of intercession

with the Bowsers for the Quechua. We believe for the translation of discipleship materials, for more extension Bible schools, for pastors to step up to the mantle of ministry within their own communities. We proclaim in faith that unreached villages will soon be filled with people testifying to a conversion experience. ¶



No one here knows Jesus' truth...

Offerings to the King of Hell

How can the Pumi be rescued from a god of hatred and death?

In a temple atop a Buddhist monastery outside the city of Lijiang in China's Tibetan Plateau, I come face to face with the King of Hell. Massive montages line the walls. The King of Hell dominates. Encircled by a ring of flames, he lifts a blue sword while trampling the bodies of victims. Crowned with a ring of human skulls, his face is a mask of rage. No one here knows Jesus' truth. As hard as it is for me to comprehend, for the Pumi people of China the King of Hell is not the personification of evil; he is their one best hope for eternity.

Award-winning photographer Gaylon Wampler and I have come to this ancient city to learn about the Pumi — a tribe of 49,000 who farm the high mountain valleys on the southern edge of the Tibetan Plateau. After visiting the temple, we search for a guide to Pumi communities in

the mountain valleys high above us. With a middle-aged Pumi man who only speaks broken English, we take a seven-hour drive.

We stop in Biche, a village of weathered log homes built around a muddy drainage ditch. At the center of the village sits an ancient log home with a clay tile roof. Inside, seemingly oblivious to our inability to understand her, an elderly woman beckons us towards the kitchen. She laughs; her face crinkles and her eyes all but disappear. The welcome is unmistakable.

Kitchens reveal the soul of a culture. At the hearth, families share meals and elders share stories that shape the values of the next

generation. There is no better place to learn about the Pumi.

The old lady gestures for us to sit on a low bench while she bustles over the fire. The wall behind the blaze bears deep smoke stains. Yet it is speckled with hundreds of tiny white ovals. Some are crisp and defined,

others are half buried in the creosote. Our guide explains that each New Year every member of the household dips their thumb in white paint and marks the wall, creating a visual history of the clan.

I can't help but ponder the hundreds of thumbprints. I wonder how many generations

the wall represents. What stories could they tell? I feel a catch in my throat as I realize I am looking at a record of generations who never had the chance to know God.

I bow my head and silently plead with the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into this corner of His harvest field.

Maybe He will send you. ¶

Reaching Europe's Secularists

When faith isn't in the picture

Europe?? Isn't this the place the apostle Paul preached nearly 2,000 years ago? Isn't this the location of the Reformation, history-altering revivals, and the origin of the King James Bible? Aren't there countless biographies of great missionaries sent from this continent, preaching Christ across the globe?

Yes, yes, and yes. All are descriptions of what Europe *was*. Where it is today is a different picture. While the Pentecostal church has been numerically exploding across much of the world, church attendance in Europe has shrunk significantly. The number of active believers is steadily dropping. The churches that are growing are either immigrant churches (mainly African and Latino) or international churches.

Magnificent cathedrals tower in most European cities, but many now serve only as concert halls or museums. Museums may be full of ancient religious paintings and symbols, but across vast regions of Europe, less than 2 percent of the people claim to know Christ. Sadly, most Europeans don't even consider God as an option. Jesus Christ is off their radar.

So if not Christianity, what is the "faith" of Europe? The current European worldview is secularism. That term may not show up as one of the world's great religions, but like any religion, it defines how people think and act. You cannot visit a Temple of Secularism or worship at the First Church of Secularism, but it is a belief system nonetheless. Secularism guides actions and behavior like any other faith.

The "religion" of secularism as a worldview does not have God (or

any god) at its center. The absolute authority in one's life is self. The horizon of eternity has vanished, and the person simply lives for today, to enjoy the moment.

AGWM missionaries and leaders have analyzed church planting and church growth in Europe. Throughout many European countries, there is statistical upward growth in the churches. But close examination

reveals disturbing news: The growth is *not* among the main indigenous European cultures but among the minority cultures of Europe. The majority of Europeans are slowly drifting away—untouched, unreached and unengaged.

This realization has spurred the AGWM Europe Region to start a new focus: The Secularist Initiative, a focus to plant churches among the secular people of Europe. We have to treat the secularist worldview like any other unreached ethnic group around the world. We need churches in Spain that are full of Spaniards and churches in France teeming with French Christians. We need to see a move of God among the Greeks and the Italians, the Portuguese and Hungarians. We need to learn how to engage the "ordinary Europeans" and plant faith communities among them. ¶

Africa's Urban Tribes

Reaching Africa's metropolitan millions

Urbanization is a global phenomenon, but Africa is urbanizing faster than anywhere else. The major African cities have blended cultures and tribes across a variety of economic scales. They are no longer defined by their historic tribal identity, but instead are forming new "urban tribes," mosaic groups that are beginning to shape Africa's cities and the continent at large.

Randy and Dezra Freeman, directors of AGWM's Urban Tribes initiative, launched into missions in Southern Africa, diligently working in poor, rural areas. They loved serving local churches, reaching out in tangible ways to compassionately minister. Their vision for Urban Tribes came during a visit to Durban, South Africa's third-largest city and its busiest port.

"Someone needs to plant a great church in this city," Randy said to Dezra. What the two of them didn't realize at that moment was that they were that "someone."

"Little did we know at that time," Randy says, "that God would begin to not just stir our hearts but stir the hearts of our leadership and eventually provide the opportunity for us as a family to move and lead a team in the city of Durban."

"Ethiopia claims to be a Christian nation," says Doug Myers, Urban Tribes coordinator for Ethiopia. "A majority of Ethiopians would claim to be Orthodox, with their historic roots coming out of the Coptic Church. But traditional thinking and beliefs around Christ for many Ethiopians are a mess. They don't believe that Christ is God. So they worship Mary, they worship saints, they worship angels. The centrality of Christ and what He did for us on the cross is missing."

Eastridge Church in Addis Ababa, the capital, is an intentional lighthouse to the city's large community of multinational Africans and expatriates. Eastridge is proclaiming a clear gospel message in an environment where truth can become obscured by tradition.

Steve and Trina Pennington make their home in Nairobi, Kenya's capital city and another burgeoning African metropolis. International Christian Center in Nairobi, is poised to bring

an Urban Tribes emphasis into the city.

"Nairobi is a city that is bursting with life," says Dennis Kabuchio, who pastored ICC's Journey ministry at the University of Nairobi and is planting a church in the next few months. "There are so many young people in Nairobi. There is so much creativity. There is so much energy. You look around, and construction is booming as more and more multinational companies are setting up their base in Nairobi."

"The love of Jesus and the power of the Holy Spirit are going to bring transformation to Nairobi and our other target cities," Randy Freeman says. "The spiritual atmosphere of these cities will be impacted by churches full of the power of the Holy Spirit." ¶
